The scale on a map is the ratio between real life sizes and how many times it has been shrunk to fit it on the map. The scale below is for a 1:50,000 scale map. At this scale, 1 cm on the map represents 50,000 cm on the ground (= 500 m or 0.5 km). Straight line distances are easy to work out if you use the scale line.

The Map Scales page states, "A 1:10,000 map will show objects 100 times as large as a 1:100,000 map but will only show 1/100th the land area on the same sized piece of paper." The 1/100th area figure is correct, but the 100 times as large should be 10 times as large. The difference is due to linear vs. area measures.
